The MORE Woods Project

- 60% of costs on self-planted woodlands up to ½ hectare
- 50% of costs on contractor planted woodland above ½ hectare
- Tree protection included
- Maintenance for first 2 years

Trees in Hedgerows Funding

The Woodland Trust is offering funding for new hedgerows through our Trees in Hedgerows scheme.

Eligibility To qualify the new hedge must link with areas of existing woodland and be at least 100 metres in length, up to a maximum of 750 metres per applicant; we will only fund more than 250 metres in conjunction with additional woodland creation.

Funding We will subsidise 60% of the total cost of the plants and guards, but cannot arrange or fund fencing or contractors to plant.

Specification The density and composition is standardised: a double row hedge with 5 plants per metre and one tree every 6 metres, with the shrubs planted in 75 cm spiral guards and trees in 1.2 metre tree shelters. The species mix will be supplied as follows:

| Species | % | per 100m |
|--------------|------------|------------|
| Hawthorn | 50 | 250 |
| Blackthorn | 10 | 50 |
| Hazel | 10 | 50 |
| Field Maple | 10 | 50 |
| Crab Apple | 5 | 25 |
| Dogwood | 5 | 25 |
| Dog Rose | 5 | 25 |
| Tree Choice | 5 | 25 |
| Total | 100 | 500 |

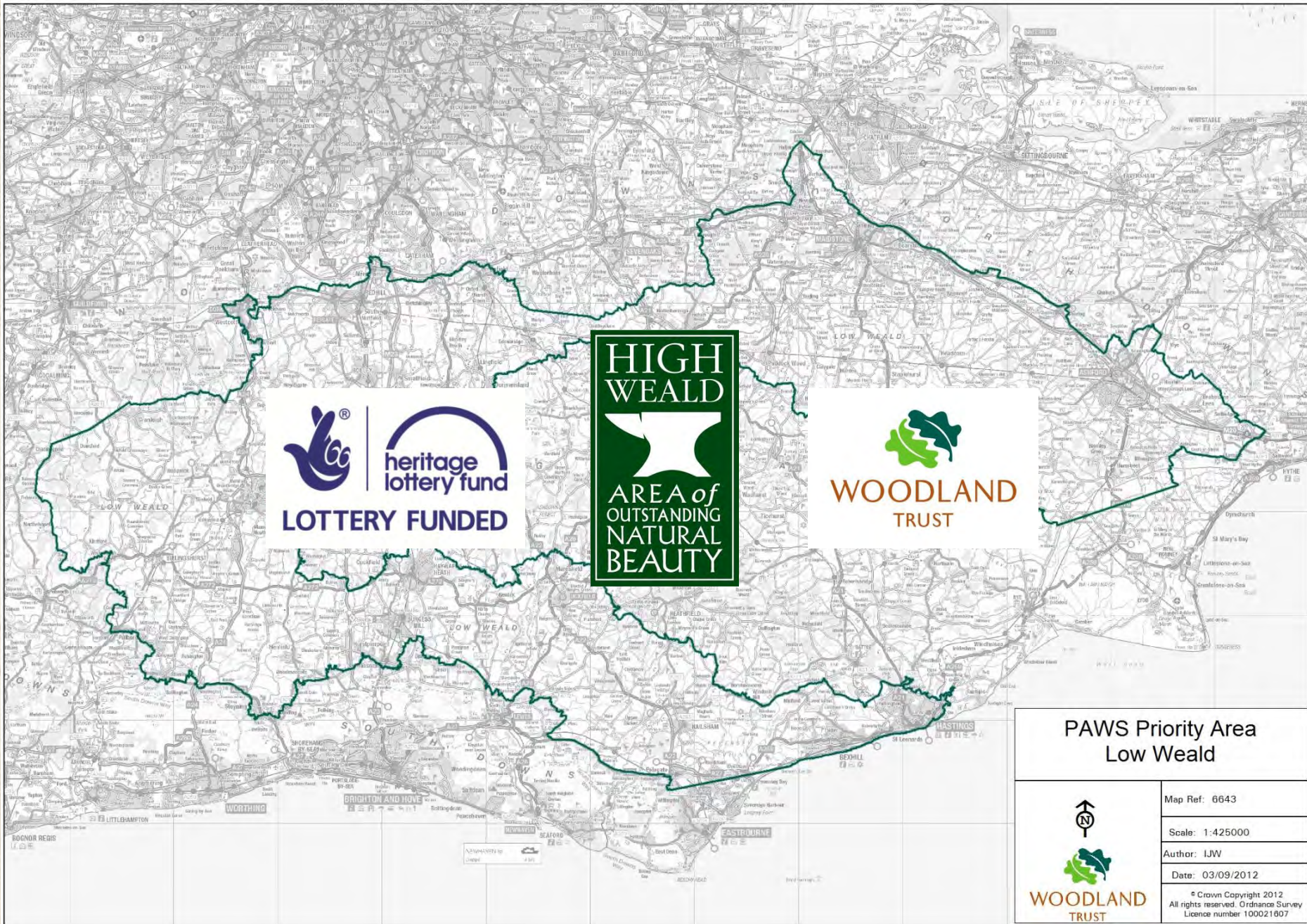
